This should not just be a photo album, but rather a record of the German Club activities. Be sure to include the name(s) of contestant(s), the school, and the city in a conspicuous place on or inside the entry.

**CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

1. **Originality and Creativity:** The album is well planned out and contestant(s) use unique creative elements in its design. The album is original and stands out when compared to other albums. (0-20 points)
2. **Contents and Organization:** The album is organized chronologically from last year's Regional Contest through the day before this year's Regional Contest. The album reflects a comprehensive record of the German Club's activities and is more than just a contest photo album. (0-20 points)
3. **Detail:** The album shows use of a variety of realia, including pictures, drawings, news clippings, original explanations, etc., to enhance the story of the German Club. (0-20 points)
4. **Presentation:** The components of the album are mounted professionally and creatively. Presentation adds to the overall story of the German Club. (0-20 points)
5. **Overall Effect:** The album has a clean, crisp look and provides great insight into the life of the German Club. (0-20 pts)
