<u>RULES</u> <u>Entry Limit:</u> One band per school: 5 – 12 musicians + 1 director (i.e. max. 13 members); 2 members may be students who have never been enrolled in German.
<u>Time Limits:</u> 5 – 10 minutes, with a 30-second grace period
All pieces of music must be from German-speaking composers. No electric instruments are allowed. No music stands will be provided at the contest site. <b>If a non-German student is included in the band, this information must be given to the judges.</b> Two copies of the <b>sheet music</b> must be provided for the judges.
CRITERIA FOR JUDGING
1. <b>Selection and preparation</b> : The selection is interesting, original and appropriate; logical transitions between songs; all the above-listed rules are followed. (0-20 points)
2. <b>Tone</b> : The contestants maintain good intonation and quality of sound. (0-20 points)
<ol> <li>Precision and instrumentation: The contestants maintain pitch, rhythm and good balance of instrumentation. (0-20 points)</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Interpretation: The contestants observe dynamics and use changes in volume, rate, and inflection as appropriate. Contestants display feeling and musicianship. (0-20 points)</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Overall effect: The contestants create and maintain a mood and have spirit; they maintain poise and have showmanship; costumes and/or make-up (if any) enhance rather than distract; the performance leaves a lasting impression. (0-20 points)</li> </ol>
