<u>RULES</u>

Entry Limit: Three entries per school: may be an individual or group project

A model is a re-creation of a specific object that exists or existed in a German-speaking country or is/was a German-Texan structure. The model must be clearly named, e.g. Kölner Dom, Brandenburger Tor, Bavarian Battle Helmet, etc and it should include a backdrop or diorama. Project should include some form of documentation as to how the original structure/object looked, from various angles if possible. Documenttation should include appropriate citation of sources. Photos of the various stages of construction would also be helpful to the judges in determining if the project was actually constructed by the contestant(s). Each entry should be labeled with the name(s) of the contestant(s), the school, and the category "Kit Model."

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- 1. **Craftsmanship**: The model is of high quality and is well constructed. Complexity of the project should also be considered. (0-20 points)
- 2. Authenticity: The model looks like the real object and the background or diorama adds to its authenticity. It is evident that the project has been well researched and includes as many authentic elements as possible. (0-20 points)
- 3. Attention to Detail: The model includes re-creation of detail, which may include inside furnishings of a structure, attention to surrounding landscapes and/or architectural detail and use of colors. (0-20 points)
- 4. Imagination: The model makes use of creative mediums and creative backdrops. (0-20 points)
- 5. **Overall Impression:** The model makes you feel as if you are seeing the real thing. A museum could use the model as part of an exhibit. (0-20 points)
